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FOOD TRUCK REGULATIONS

Location requirements

- Trucks must be parked on paved surfaces and may not block drive aisles, or emergency access.
- Trucks must park:
 - At least 30 feet from the Right-of-way of SR 54 or SR 74,
 - At least 15 feet from a fire hydrant or transformer,
 - At least 200 feet from a brick-and-mortar restaurant while open, and
 - At least 300 feet from a school or daycare while in session unless written approval is provided.

Operational requirements

- Mobile food trucks must display a valid permit at all times.
- Any driver of a mobile food truck must possess a valid driver's license issued by the state.
- No vehicle or equipment shall be stored on the vending site when sales are not taking place.
- Each vendor shall comply with all state, federal and local health and safety regulations and shall obtain and maintain all licenses required.
- Vendors may sell food and non-alcoholic beverages only.
- The following safety regulations shall apply to all vehicles used for mobile food truck establishments:
 - Vehicles shall be equipped with a reverse gear signal alarm audible outside the truck, and
 - Vehicles shall be equipped with two rear-vision mirrors, one firmly attached to each side.
- Customers shall be provided with single service articles such as plastic utensils and paper plates.
- Each vendor shall provide at least one waste container for public use. Vendor must remove waste from the site before the vehicle departs.
- Absolutely no dumping of gray water on public or private property shall be permitted.
- All power required for the mobile food truck shall be self-contained. Mobile food trucks shall not use utilities drawn from the right-of-way. No cables may extend across any city street, multi-use path, or sidewalk.

Aesthetic/signage requirements.

- Absolutely no flashing, blinking or strobe lights may be used, or special effects that produce motion pictures; emit visible smoke or vapor; or produce any motion or movement. No sign shall be internally illuminated. All exterior lights over 60 watts shall have opaque hood shields to direct light downward.
- All signs must be permanently affixed to or painted on the vehicle and shall extend no more than 6 inches.
- A portable menu board no more than 6 square feet may be placed on the ground within the customer waiting area. This sign shall be no more than 10 FT from the mobile food truck.
- Mobile food trucks shall be maintained in good condition with no structural damage, holes, or visible rust, and shall be fully street legal. Vehicles may not spill oil/fuel, coolant, grease or other material.
